## OUR MISSION

SouthFair's mission is to provide sustainable housing for low and moderate income families through multifamily, single family, economic development and connectivity of social services for an overall revitalization of the South Dallas community.

You can apply for additional Texas Rent Relief rental and utility assistance, now that 60 days have passed since you received our last program assistance.

At this time, you may apply for any past-due months for which you have not already received assistance, as well as your current month and **two future months of rent.**

Please keep in mind that:

- You are limited to receiving a total of 15 months of rent and/or utility assistance from the program.
- You can only receive the additional assistance after three months have passed from the date of your last program payment.
- 

To submit your application for additional rental and/or utility assistance:

1. Sign in to the TRRP application system.
2. You will see a pop-up notification that says you are eligible to apply for additional funds. Click "Proceed" to start your application.
3. Complete all information requested in the application and add any required documents.
4. Sign and submit your application.

# Voting Rights

## General Information

### Accepted ID

IDs issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)

- Texas Driver License;
- Texas Election Identification Certificate;
- Texas Personal Identification Card; and
- Texas Handgun License.

IDs issued by a U.S. Federal Agency

- U.S. Military Identification Card (with photo);
- United States Citizenship Certificate (with photo); and
- United States Passport (book or card).

If the voter has one of these, they have to use it.

### FAQ

Can I vote with an expired ID?

- **YES**

Can tribal IDs, out-of-state licenses, or voter registration certificates be used as a primary form of ID for voting?

- **NO**

Can I vote if I'm being prosecuted or if I have been indicted?

- **YES**

If I ask for assistance, will someone help me?

- **YES**

Can I ask for an interpreter if I don't understand the language?

- **YES**

Can I ask for an interpreter to help me communicate with the election officials?

- **YES**

Can someone who is homeless register and vote?

- **YES**

Do I need a mailing address to register to vote?

- **YES**

Can I still register to vote at my current location even if I just started living there today?

- **YES**

### If You Don't Have an Accepted ID

If you don't have one of the pre-approved IDs and **cannot reasonably obtain one**, you will be asked to sign a special form known as a "**Reasonable Impediment Declaration**," and will be asked to bring one of the following forms of identification: paycheck, bank statement, birth certificate, out-of-state driver's license, etc.

The only reasonable impediments that the state allows are:

- Lack of transportation;
- Disability or illness;
- Lack of birth certificate or other documents needed to obtain acceptable photo ID;
- Work schedule;
- Family responsibilities;
- Lost or stolen photo ID; and
- Photo ID applied for but not received.

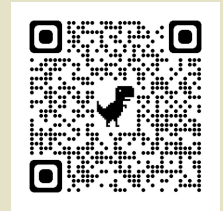
# COVID-19 BOOSTER SHOTS

For individuals who received a Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine, the following groups are eligible for a booster shot at 6 months or more after their initial series:

- 65 years and older
- Age 18+ who live in long-term care settings
- Age 18+ who have underlying medical conditions
- Age 18+ who work or live in high-risk settings

For the nearly 15 million people who got the Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine, booster shots are also recommended for those who are 18 and older and who were vaccinated two or more months ago.

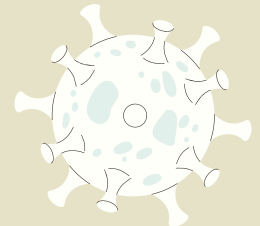
# CANDY CORN PUNCH
